In April, 2013, Pro-Cut donated an on-car brake lathe to the Delancey Street Foundation in Los Angeles, CA.

Delancey Street Foundation is a nonprofit organization operating in five U.S. cities that helps former substance abusers, ex-convicts, homeless people and others rebuild their lives. All residents learn a marketable skill and at least a high-school equivalency degree. When ready, residents enter one of the multiple vocational schools, which include a program in automotive service training.

The Foundation functions as an extended family. No one draws a salary; there is no staff. Delancey is run by the residents themselves. All money is funneled into the community, and each resident receives food, housing, clothing, education, entertainment and all other services at no cost.
